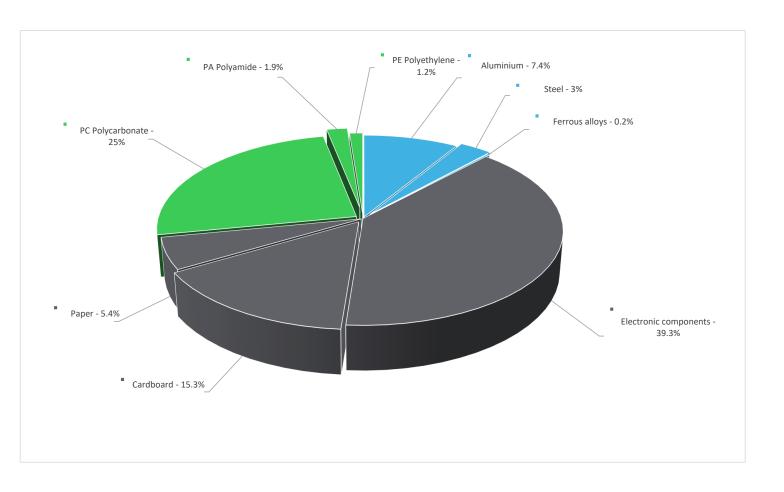

Functional unit	Manages the communication between Exiway Smart Control and Exiway Dicube Luminaires. The communication is based on Dali Protocol and it is possible to connect up 128 Exiway Dicube Luminaires, divided in 2 lines of max 64 devices This product is provided for 10 years but actually it can be extended to more.
Specifications are:	The Smart Console is powered by 230VA with max 13W of consumption. The output on both lines is 16VDC with current limitation at max 235 mA. The product is designed to operate for 10 years thanks to its IP20 protection rating. The consumption of the product during its declared lifetime is 113 kWh (The usage scenario was considered according to the reference PSR which is a 100% standby mode for 10 years (8760 h/year)).
